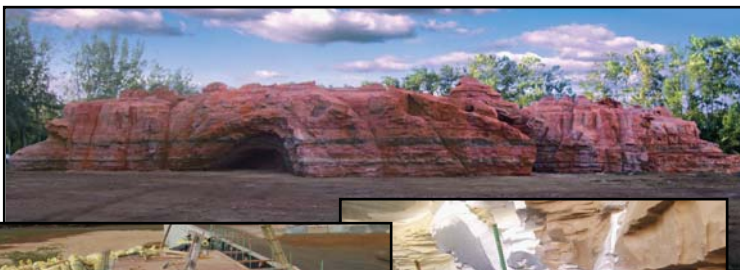

Background:

For over 9 years Forest Boone has communicated the natural process of geomorphous, talus breaks, moss and lichen growth, wind and water gaps through his rock creations. With 6 U.S. design patents and projects throughout the country, Museumrock Products has created formations for: bronze statue bases, animal habitats, amusement parks, science museums, hotels and casinos, corporate headquarters and swimming pools. Museumrock Products uses KLEEN KOTE as a release agent to facilitate in the creation of detailed surface formations such as the Navajo Indian Memorial in Hawaii.

Use:

Museumrock Products designed what may be the world's largest form liner mold to create and build the Navajo Indian Memorial in Na Aina Kai Botanical Gardens. This 136-foot long and over 20-foot tall re-creation of a giant rock formation includes two cliff faces split apart to create a canyon and a dead-end cave. In order to create the textured rock surface, Museumrock Products hand sculpts the first 2 inches or so of the 2-pound density E.P.S. Styrofoam mold. With a total of 57 mold sections, many of them as large as 19'x4'x40", Museumrock Products uses KLEEN KOTE to ensure that the hand sculpted detail is transferred to the finished product and that all the molds release easily. The project encompassed 122 yards of grout, 17,000 lbs. of dry pigment, 12,000 lbs. of epoxy coated rebar, 3,000 lbs. of stainless steel tubing and 5 barges of specific color sand from Asia.

Results:

Perfect Detail throughout the entire formation – The only release agent of its kind to create a finished surface without imperfections when sprayed directly onto the hand sculpted molds

Economical and Easy to Use – Shipped in concentrate form to mix on-site as needed and sprayed directly on the molds prior to use; no special equipment, clothing or tools required

Environmentally and User Friendly – Biodegradable (no silicones, solvents or phosphates), V.O.C. compliant, water-based; will not contaminate the grounds and surrounding grounds and vegetation and is safe for anyone handling or using the product

Durable Protectant – Able to withstand the entire project, whether halted by weather; will not rinse off in rain

Museumrock Products was able to complete the rock formation with ease and perfection by using KLEEN KOTE on their form liner molds. Museumrock Products has been using KLEEN KOTE since 2004 and was happy with the profound success on this project. The company has recently used KLEEN KOTE on another project--the creation of a Lincoln Memorial. We plan on many future endeavors amongst Progressive Solutions' KLEEN KOTE and Museumrock Products.
